
Every country on our planet has its own unique heritage to offer. The reflection of a rich and sometimes moving history. But more recent attractions also reflect a country's spirit and dynamism.

Portraits of knights, painters or other historic legends and icons look best on a 3D minted coin. 3D provides a better representation of the person and his expression. See the example of the coin of Willem van Oranje.

Manufacturing...

To manufacture a high quality souvenir coin from initial idea to finished product, four different steps have to be taken:



STEP 1

To start designing a good image is needed. This image will preferably be a high resolution picture or another type of document.

Postcards are the best alternative, as these usually show the best angle and quality of a monument etc.



STEP 2

Pre-design, is a draft of the coin scaled to its final and actual measurement complete with text and other optional details.

Thanks to the state-of-the-art, high-end manufacturing techniques, years of experience and expert craftsmanship, no detail has to be left out.



STEP 3

Technical drawing, this is the technical representation of the souvenir coin itself. It features instructions about the manufacturing details. This file is used to manufacture the die, also called the matrix.



STEP 4

Matrix, coins are minted in one strike with two customised matrices to produce the highest quality coin. A truly unique souvenir.







The Dispenser...

Sleek and compact design

Dimensions

Height 184 CM Width 54 CM 45 CM Depth

Weight 65 KG (without souvenir coins)

Modest dimensions combined with discreet, but stylish colours mean that the dispenser will fit into almost any environment. Customised colours can be obtained.

Top panel

- Clear transparent
- Illuminated from below in the dispenser

This panel is engraved with the image on a coin representing the location and is clearly visible, even from a distance. Its purpose is to attract potential buyers by displaying an enlarged image of the coin design.

Electronic coin mechanism

- Equipped with a stainless steel front cover
- Coin acceptance: 32 active channels for up to 16 different coins
- Heavy-duty coin acceptor with very easy handling and programming functions

Front cover

- Clear transparent with a gloss finish
- Full-colour digital printing on the backside
- Glued and screw-mounted to the carriage

This cover is printed with the universal image of the country and is customisable.

Illuminated coin display

• The coin is displayed against a black background and is illuminated from above

This is a very attractive feature of the coin dispenser. People can actually see the real coins in the display unit. The reflection of the light on the coin enhances its beauty and promotes impulse buying.

Secured carriage

- Can be opened for servicing and maintenance
- Secured by a vertical 6-point mechanism and cylinder safety lock

The carriage is mounted on a sledge and contains all the components for coin acceptance and dispensing as well as all the electronics.

The power supply is mounted on the back of the interior housing.

Solid steel housing, foot and poles

- Steel 37.2 MM (housing, poles), 3 MM (foot)
- Zinc treated against corrosion
- Powder coated, also on the inside
- Coin tray in stainless steel

Hardware

- 2 individual coin hoppers, each with a 1.200 coin capacity (diameter 31.00 MM)
- Automatic switching between hoppers when a hopper is empty or out of order
- Tailor-made electronics and controls
- Standard 220V-24V power supply

Software

- LCD display with feedback texts in any desired language
- Easy-to-use parameter settings and read-outs with button controls:
- · amount received
- number of coins out left hopper
- number of coins out right hopper
- accumulative counters
- hopper emptying function


